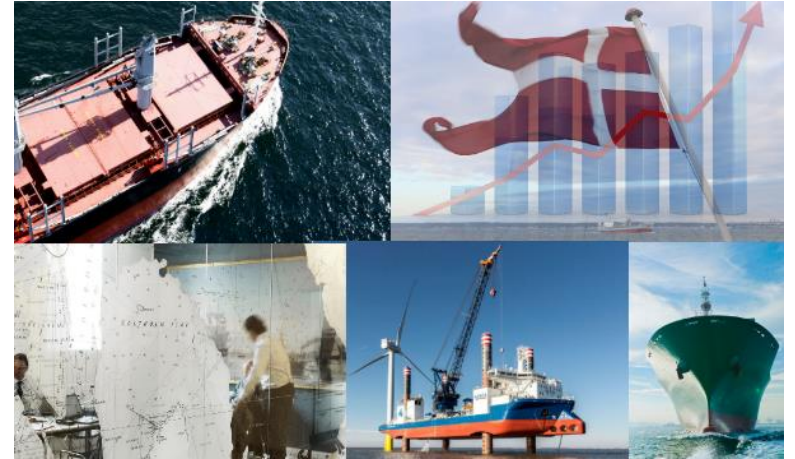

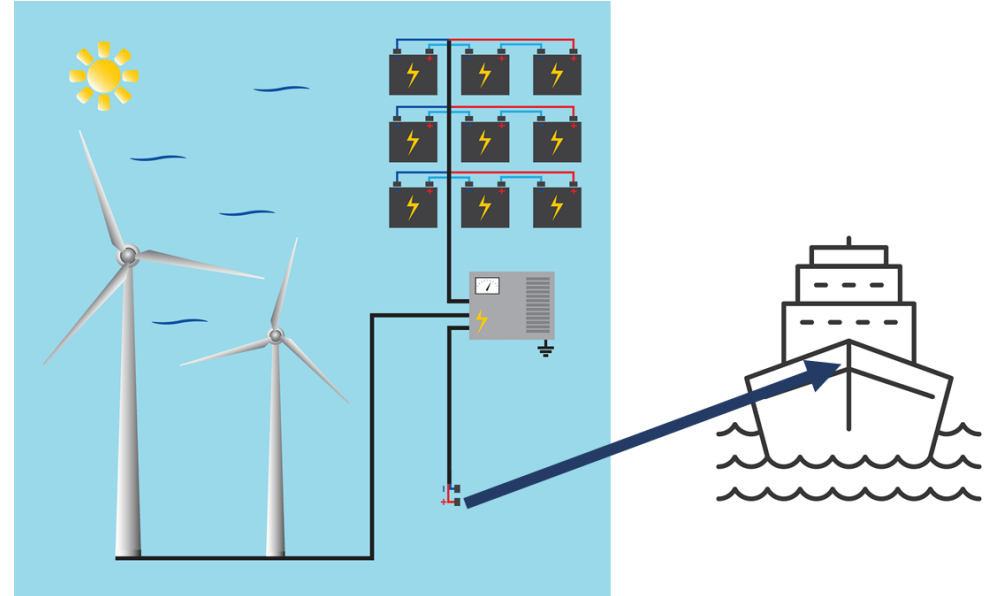
SHIPPING ORGANISATION IN PUBLIC DENMARK

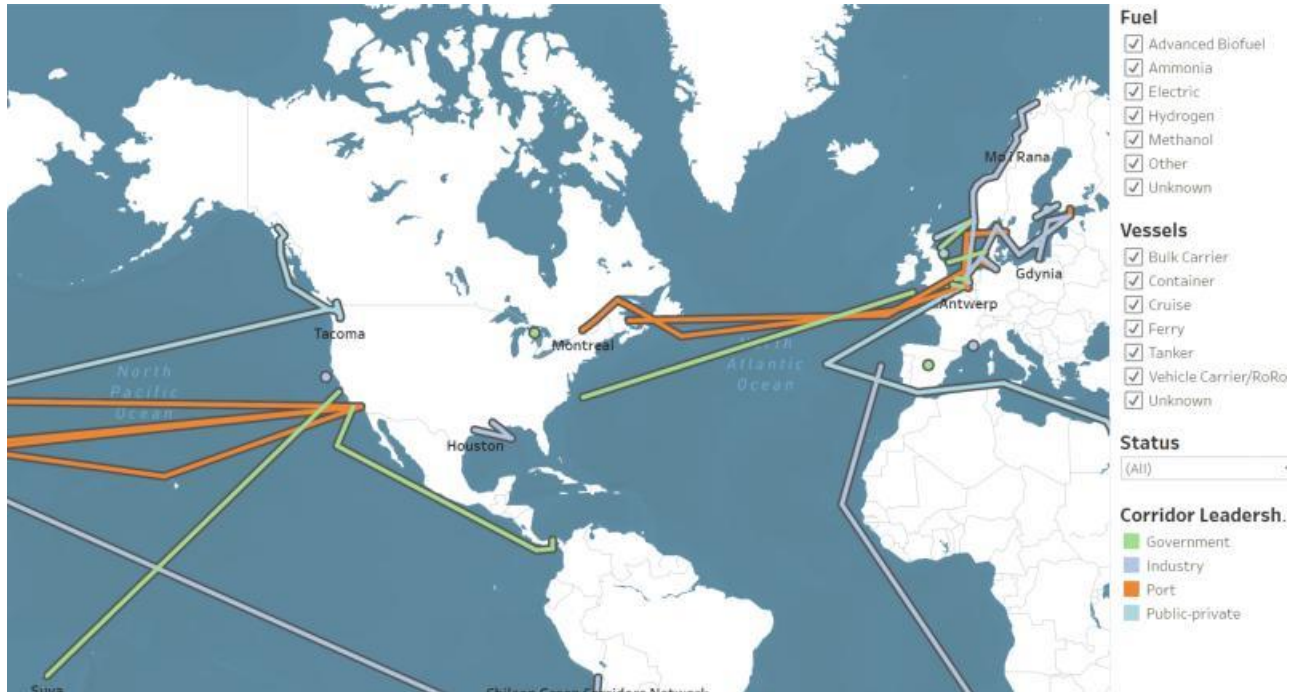

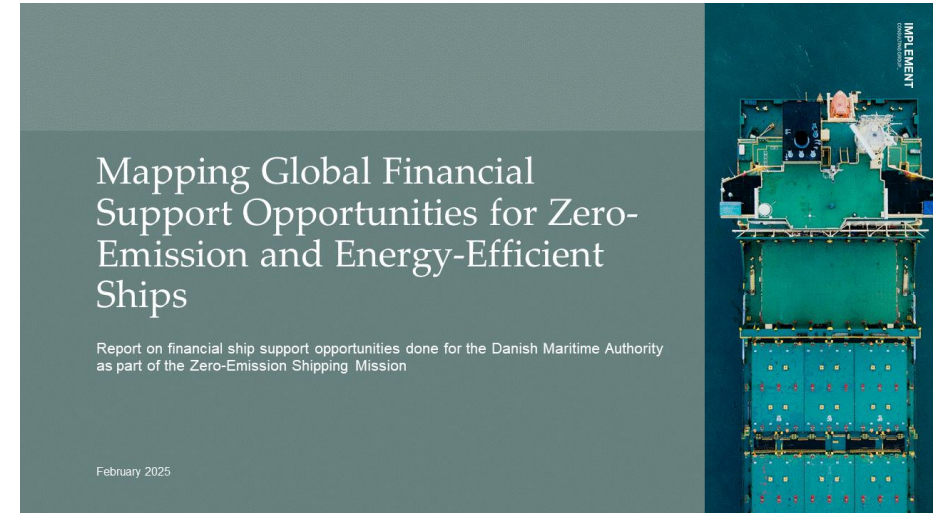
